## ACHIEVMENTS

The organization have conducted massive community mobilization and sensitization on issues like family planning, sanitation and hygiene, HIV/AIDS, agriculture and education.

50 families have been selected and supported tree planting project (5000 eucalyptus trees) of that is aimed at environmental conservation.

80 beneficiaries have so far registered (children and elderly) after rigorous community mapping exercise and children from these families are supported with scholastic materials to support them during the education.
