## ACHIEVEMENTS

Increased use of fertilizers by small holder farmers which has increased their harvest by 30%. Most small holder farmers have also adopted the better methods of land management.

We have contributed towards mitigating unwanted pregnancies among the school going girls, this have been achieved through our school based sensitization. This achieved have positively impacted on reducing girls child school dropout

Trees that would have been cut and used to make local shades are now being protected due to the use of Tents (tent hiring).

We acquired a grant from the local government of Uganda under community driven development (CDD) program. We bought one tent and 35 plastic chairs; the project is generating income to the organization which is supporting our organization to meet the administration costs, buying beans seeds that are given to our beneficiaries.

We have constructed one pig sty at a capacity of 20 pigs.
