Obusinga Bwa Rwenzururu's (OBB) mission is to invoke a shared identity and cultural allegiance so as to raise the quality of life.

History

The Obusinga Bwa Rwenzururu (OBR) is a cultural institution for those living Rwenzori Mountain region. The roots of the OBR stretch far back in the 1890s.

The Kingdom has persevered and evolved through various phases in its long history. In the early 1990s, in response to the people's call to action, the government of Uganda renewed its constitutional

recognition of the importance of cultural ties and in 2009 the government officially recognized OBR.

OBR's **vision** is: A well cultured, peaceful and prosperous people united by shared history.

The **core values** are:

- *Cultural growth in language and standards of conduct
- *Drawing pride in Rwenzori Mountain , especially the snow capped peaks

- *Reconciliation, peaceful coexistence and unity
- *Educational advancement
- *A prospering people

Their overarching **goal** is to have a community that is culturally developed and fully organized to preserve its values and adapt them to changes.

The Environment

OBR works towards preserving the snow cover on the Rwenzori Mountain and ensuring sustainable utilization of the natural resources through reforestation, afforestation, protection of wetlands, promoting energy saving technologies, climate change awareness seminars, and the development of cultural sites for tourism

Health and HIV & AIDS

OBR contributes towards efforts to reduce incidences of mortality and morbidity through disease prevention awareness campaigns and the promotion of herbal medicine in collaboration with research institutions.

Education

OBR promotes efforts to enhance reading and writing as well as the importance of sport for self-reliance. OBR wishes to see every school-age child stay in school until completion. The organization supports a scholarship fund, the development of local languages,

early childhood development and functional adult literacy.

Milestones

*A scholarship fund which has supported over 100 students in the completion of higher education.

*Sensitization of the population on reforestation, protection of wetlands and promoting energy saving technologies.

*OBR planted two forests in 2011 with approximately1000 trees in each.

*OBR has developed two cultural sites for tourism.
